## SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

A) Morning Assembly

8.15 a.m. to 8.30 a.m. is the Assembly time. Pledge, Thought, News, Role plays, Speech, General Knowledge Questions, and activities related to important weeks like Vigilance Awareness Week, Science Week etc. are presented in the daily assembly.
